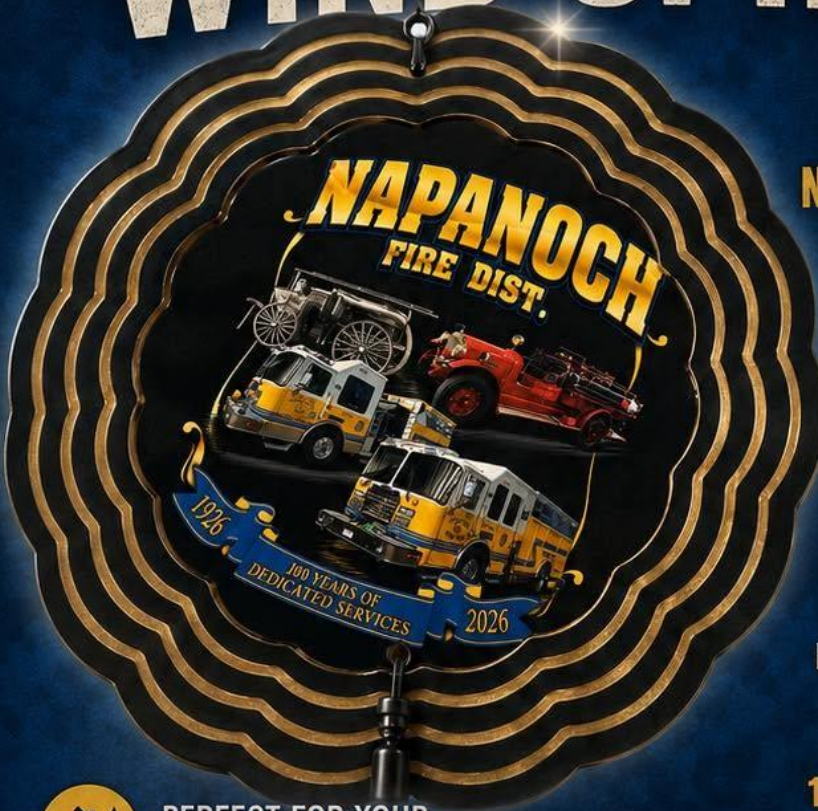

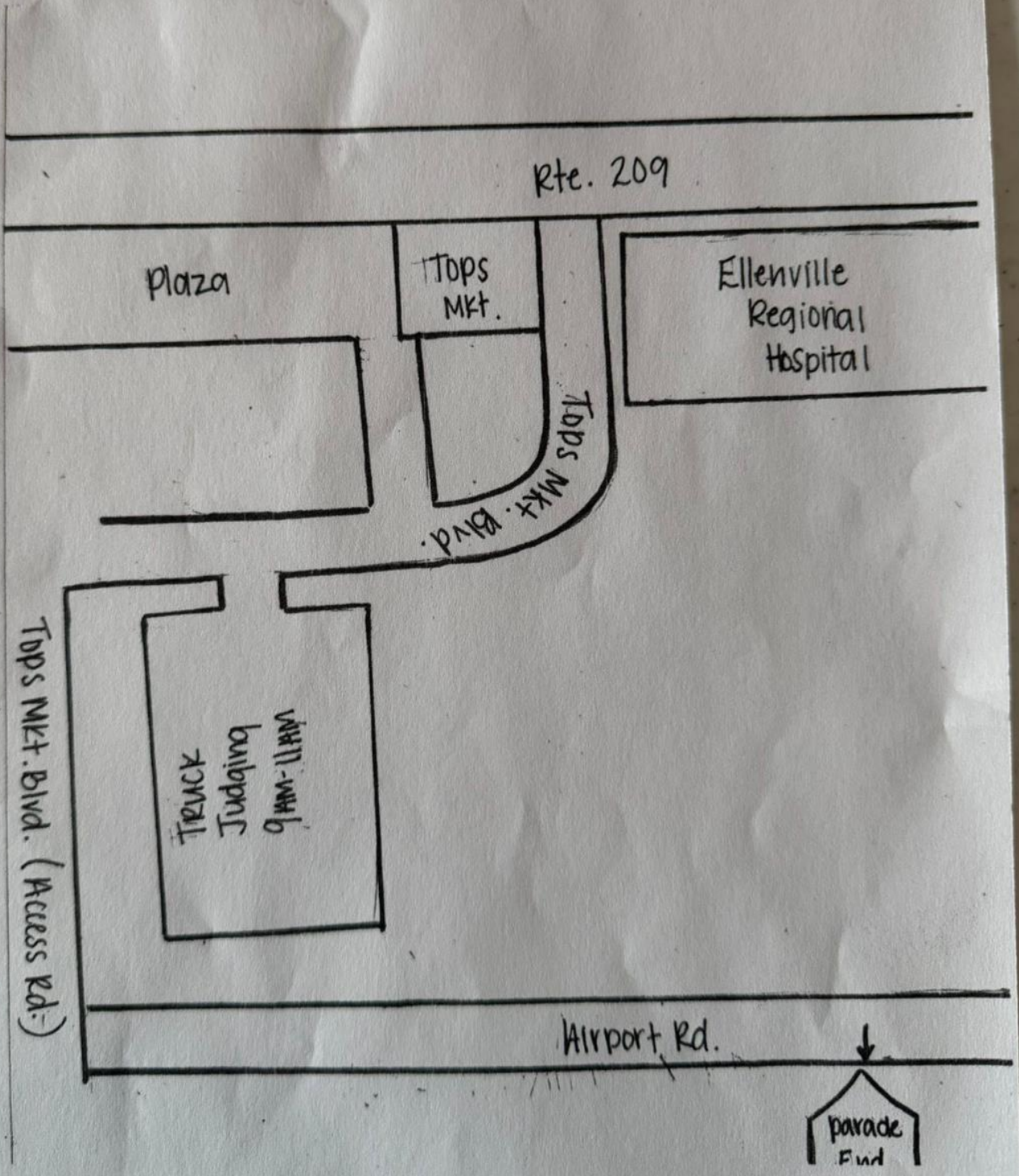

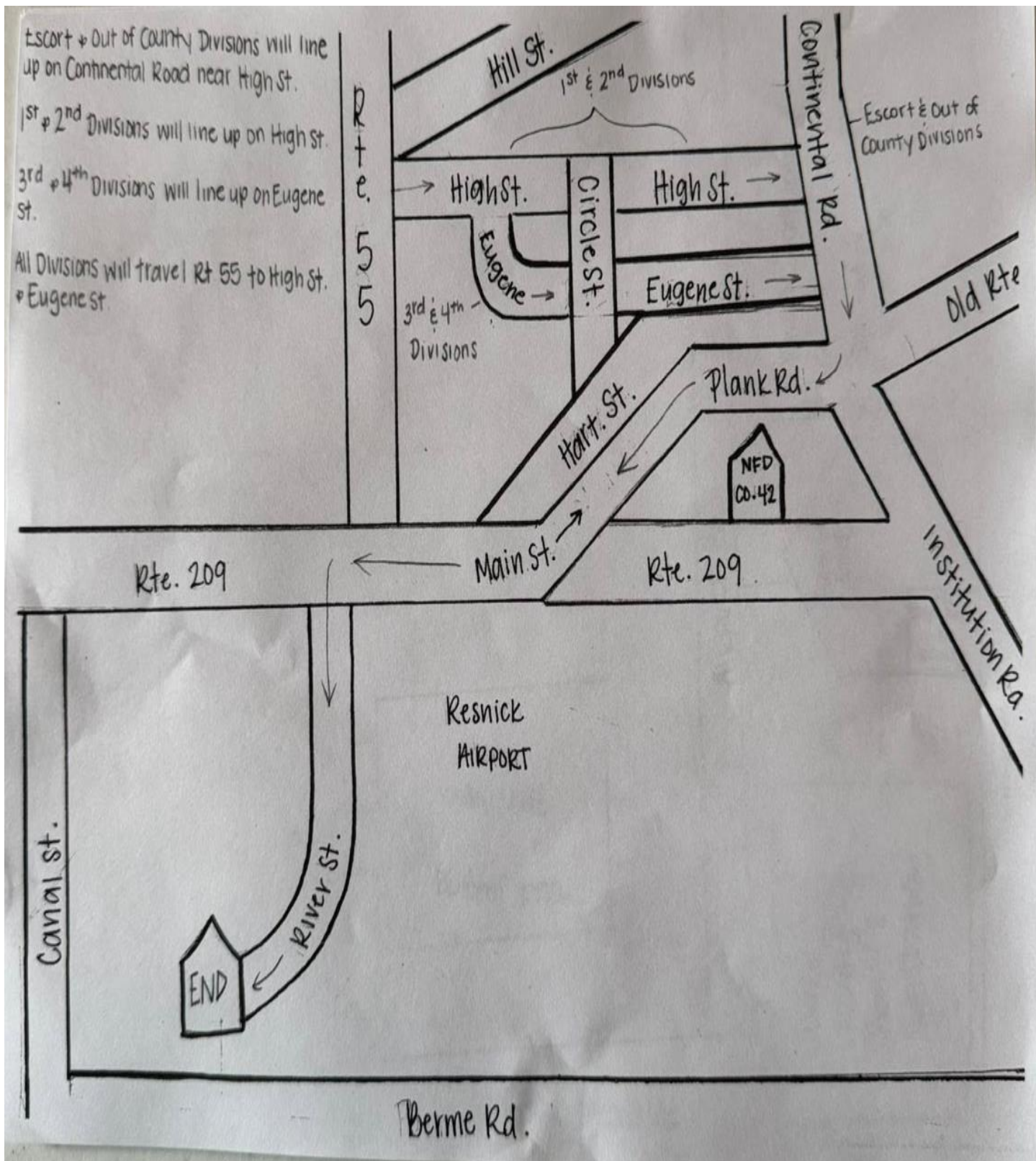


Truck Judging

Marlboro 'wets down' \$190,000 fire truck

MARLBORO — Blue-and-white confetti was strewn across the floor of the Marlborough Hose Company building yesterday, a sign of the welcoming celebration for a new \$190,000 fire truck.

About 100 volunteer firefighters and local residents attended the "wet down" during which confetti, instead of water, was used to christen the new pumper. The truck, which pumps 1,500 gallons per minute, replaces a 30-year-old piece of equipment.

Also on hand, amidst the tables, balloons, hot dogs, and soft drinks, was Assemblyman Lawrence E. Bennett, D-Newburgh. He received a plaque for securing a \$70,000 "members item" grant to assist in the truck's purchase.

The rest of the money came from fire district taxes and fund raising, said Fire Chief Robert Troncillito. "Right now we're in good shape," Troncillito said.

The effort started around May 1986 when Troncillito first contacted Bennett about state funding that might be available. It led to a lengthy paper trail before the state funding was approved in May 1987. The final check arrived last Friday, Troncillito said, and the truck has been in the station since November.

The company operates five pieces of equipment with 40 active members and a full membership of about 150 people, Troncillito said. The department covers about 16 square miles in the town.

Bennett acknowledged that it's probably easier to get

funding for this type of item because it has a visible, immediately recognizable value. In addition, it assists a group that operates solely on a volunteer level.

"It promotes something that's very good in our society — volunteerism," Bennett said.

Around him, firefighters from Highland, New Paltz, Plattekill, Maybrook and Middle Hope — the confetti throwers — socialized and checked out the pumper set between two other trucks.

"We take pride in any new equipment," said Kevin Casey, the fire district's first assistant chief. The "wet down," he said, "is a tradition. It's a chance to take special pride in what we do and to share it with our neighboring companies and the community."

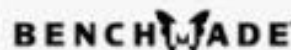
