RAPID INTERVENTION CREW (NFPA 1407 - 2020 ED.) (01-05-0133)

Full Description: The NYS Rapid Intervention Crew (2024 edition) is designed as an advanced course wherein experienced firefighters, utilizing components from previous courses, build knowledge, skills, and abilities in the task of operating as a rapid intervention crew (RIC). Students will utilize individual skill sessions in addition to working as a team to affect a rescue of downed firefighter(s). The main focus of this course is solely routed in locating, disentangling and extricating the firefighter with mayday/urgent situations. These skills are based on best practices and recommended training topics located in NFPA 1407 Standard for Training Fire Service Rapid Intervention Crews, 2020 Edition. Students completing this course will have added advanced skills that will prepare them to respond as a part of a rapid intervention crew during various incidents. This is a hands on expedited and focused course with minimal classroom time.
